

BSN trained nurse home visitors provide services to first time low-income pregnant women less than 28 weeks pregnant at enrollment. One by One Ministries Christian Faith-based home visitation program where clients are matched with mentors. Program serves pregnant women and parents through the baby's first year (with the option of continuing for a second year). Skilled workers provide relational support to promote mother-child attachment and early brain development. Participants can be enrolled anytime during pregnancy, and until the baby is 3 months old.
